The Bay Dental Practice offers a dental experience which is relaxing, friendly and where your child's needs come first. We aim to be pro-active in the prevention of tooth decay and gum disease through the use of proven preventive techniques and individually tailored health promotion advice. Today's youngsters can benefit from the significant advances made in the prevention of dental disease - giving them a smile they can be proud of for the rest of their lives.

Many of our adult patients benefit from the advantages of a preventive based membership plan. We have now joined with DPAS Limited to extend this opportunity to the whole family, allowing us to reward and look after our younger patients who attend the practice regularly. This plan is administered by DPAS, who will make a separate arrangement with you to manage your payments under the plan. Joining entitles your child to regular dental care and access to our clinical team when needed, as well as a range of additional benefits.



Additional Benefits

- a warranty on any dental work at the practice
- treatment planning to promote good dental health for life
- screening for mouth cancer and dental diseases
- access to a 24 hour dental emergency helpline 365 days per year
- eligibility to request assistance from the Worldwide Dental Emergency Assistance Scheme (see overleaf).



We offer 2 levels of membership

Children (6-12 years) cost £6.80 per month and covers:

- 1 dental health examination per year
- 2 preventive visits (hygienist/therapist) for diet advice and toothbrushing instruction.

Teenagers (13-18 years) cost £9.00 per month and covers:

- 1 dental health examination per year
- 2 preventive visits (hygienist/therapist) for diet advice and toothbrushing instruction
- sports gum shields at laboratory cost (only laboratory fees to pay).

Both levels also include:

- free orthodontic assessments
- free small x-rays*
- free fluoride applications*
- 20% off fissure sealants
- 20% off white fillings
- 20% off crowns
- membership card with 24 hour helpline numbers for dental emergencies at home or abroad
- eligibility to request assistance from the Worldwide Dental Emergency Assistance Scheme (see overleaf).

* where clinically necessary.

Infant Membership (0-5 years) is free for children whose parents benefit from adult membership. Children on the Infant Membership are not eligible for assistance from the Worldwide Dental Emergency Assistance Scheme. Details are in the adult membership brochure.

Membership numbers are limited so that we can maintain our level of customer service.

The monthly plan cost includes the charges for management and administration payable by you to DPAS.

Treatment not covered by this plan can be paid for separately.

How your child can become a member

There is no need for an assessment. All you have to do is complete a registration form for us and a Direct Debit mandate and authorisation form for DPAS, on behalf of your child.

In addition to your first monthly payment, an initial registration fee of £10 per child will be payable by you to DPAS and will be included in your first Direct Debit payment.

How do I end my child's membership?

Membership is a 12 month commitment. If you wish to end your child's Membership after that, you can do so by simply giving us one month's notice.

HOW DOES THE WORLDWIDE DENTAL EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE SCHEME WORK?

Whilst a member of the dental plan, should you suffer a dental trauma, a dental emergency or be diagnosed with oral cancer you will be eligible to make a request for assistance from the Worldwide Dental Emergency Assistance Scheme. The Scheme responds to such requests on a wholly discretionary basis. This means that, whilst the Scheme aims to provide benefits in most cases, the Scheme has no obligation to provide any benefit unless the Scheme Manager (the person appointed to administer the Scheme) first decides (in its sole and absolute discretion) that the Scheme should provide a benefit. There are some circumstances in which the Scheme is not designed to help (these situations being similar to exclusions under an insurance policy) and these are explained in more detail in the Worldwide Dental Emergency Assistance Scheme Handbook. The Scheme Manager will look at each case individually to assess the request for a benefit. Certain restrictions and limitations may apply in the event that your request for assistance is accepted and it is possible that in some cases the Scheme Manager will decide to provide no benefit.

If your request for assistance is accepted by the Scheme Manager you will be eligible to receive benefit payments from the Scheme in the following situations (up to the limits set by the Scheme and published from time to time):

- ✓ The cost of dental treatment by any dentist up to a maximum of £10,000 for any one incident of dental trauma
- ✓ The cost of:
 - emergency call-outs
 - pain relief or emergency temporary treatment
- ✓ A specified amount for each complete 24-hour period of hospitalisation wholly or partly under the care of a consultant who specialises in dental or maxillofacial surgery
- ✓ A specified amount if you are diagnosed with oral cancer and this is the primary cancer site

You will also have 24 hour access to a worldwide dental emergency helpline.

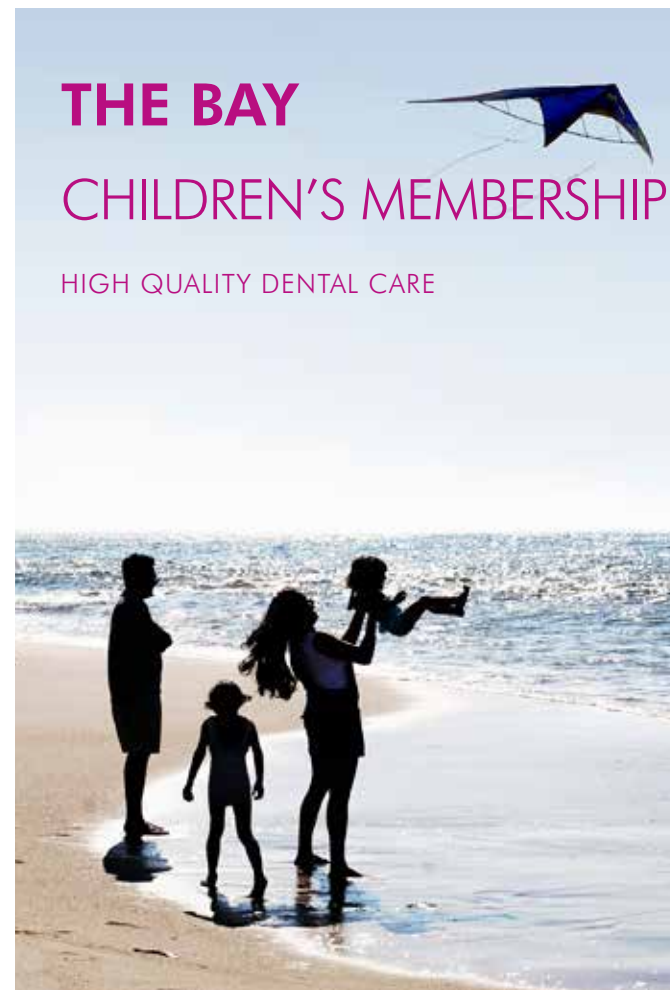
